



Design size: 61/4" x 83/4"

What Inspires Us

Have you wondered where a needlework teacher gets their ideas, what inspires them? Then this is the lecture for you. It will give you some small insight into what teachers may be thinking when they come up with that design that seems to tell a story.

Needlepoint Discovers Handmade Paper

This lecture covers Dawn's journey in the Teacher cum Laude program with the National Academy of Needlearts, which was about exploring another form of art within needlepoint. She chose handmade paper as the medium and used it to create new and exciting pieces. The lecture will share what she learned about the handmade paper process, some art she discovered and the designs she created.

Stitching Diagonally

This is a 60 minute lecture designed to explore some of the background on why Dawn wrote and self-published her book, *Transformative Stitching: Needlework on the Diagonal.* Created from her love of this technique. The lecture provides hints on how to overcome the intimidation of the technique, how stitches can be rotated, and finally, provides the stitcher with some confidence to create their own "transformations".

Lifecycle of a New Needlepoint Piece

Many, especially non stitchers, don't know what a teacher/designer goes through during the process of a creating a new piece. To share this process, Dawn put together a grouping of 12 pictures, which can be displayed during the lecture or at any needleart exhibit.

The interest from NAN's annual exhibit inspired the lecture, which focuses on one of her designs, "Pieces of the Past" and takes one through that journey.
